7:40pm Brief Update on the CA Department of Water Resources Prop 1: Disadvantaged Community Involvement Grant Project by Sheridan N. Enomoto of Greenaction for Health and Environmental Justice

-Proposition 1, approved by the voters in 2014, includes targeted funding for Disadvantaged Community (DAC) assistance, project studies and project implementation. The Disadvantage Community Involvement Program is a Prop 1 Project.

-According to the CA Department of Water Resources, "the Disadvantaged Community Involvement Program (DACIP) is designed to ensure the involvement of disadvantaged communities (DACs), economically distressed areas (EDAs), or underrepresented communities (collectively referred to as DACs) in IRWM (Integrated Regional Water Management) planning efforts." Grantees of the Program will directly assess water concerns and issues in their communities.

-The first round of grantees/communities for the Bay have been selected. Grantees include the community of BVHP. The DACIP in BVHP will evaluate community water concerns and bring awareness of sea-level rise, illegal dumping in relation to stormwater drainage, and subsistence fishing.
